OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Overton made the motion to approve the September 9, 2008 minutes with a second by Commissioner McAlpin the motion passed unanimously.

Resolution #2009-15

The resolution accepts the Highway Safety Grant in the amount of \$5,000 from the State to the Sheriff's Department with no local match. The grant is to be used to purchase vehicle in-car video equipment, DUI checkpoint supplies, and other law enforcement supplies. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Resolution #2009-16

The resolution allows Weakley County Government to enter into a contract with the State of Tennessee Office of Criminal Justice Programs for the provisions of providing treatment services for the Benton County Drug Court Program of the 24th Judicial District for the period of September 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$41,692 with no local match required. This is being done at the request of the State of Tennessee Office of Criminal Justice Programs to General Sessions Judge Tommy Moore for Weakley County's judicial and fiscal assistance to ensure ten outstanding participants complete the program. Commissioner McAlpin made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Vincent the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Wright made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Stewart the meeting adjourned at 4:07 p.m.
