

**WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE  
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE  
JUNE 12, 2008 4:00 p.m.**

**Public Safety Members Present:** Commissioners Roger Stewart, Earl Wright, Kevin McAlpin, John Salmon, and Jack Vincent.

The Public Safety Committee met on Thursday, June 12, 2008 at 4:00 p.m. at the Weakley County Department of Finance in the conference room. Others present included Shawn Francisco-Director of Finance, Houston Patrick-County Mayor, Keith Jones-Juvenile Service Officer, Pam Belew-Circuit Court Clerk, and Sheriff Mike Wilson.

Chairman Jack Vincent called the meeting the order.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Commissioner McAlpin made the motion to approve the June 4, 2008 minutes with a second by Commissioner Stewart.

**Meth Budget 08-09 FY**

The Meth Budget was approved by the State of TN for a period of two years with total reimbursement up to \$200,000 per year. Carroll County Academy will not accept Weakley County kids unless Weakley County sends \$90,000 to the Academy. Weakley County normally sends 35-45 kids per year to Carroll Academy. Commissioner McAlpin made the motion to send the Meth Budget forward and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Resolution #2008-52**

The resolution addressed the need for realignment within the Drug Control Fund due to the increase in Drug Control Fines and Proceeds from Confiscated Property and the corresponding increase to expenditure line item 54150.709, Data Processing Equipment. The FWM Committee previously approved the resolution. Commissioner Stewart made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Vincent the motion passed unanimously.

**Resolution #2008-47**

The resolution regards T.C.R.S. Retirement change in deputies and was previously on the floor for discussion only. Commissioner Stewart made the motion to move the resolution off the table for discussion and with a second by Commissioner McAlpin the motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Stewart discussed no longevity pay to deputies. An increase of 3.5% in the accrued liability rate would cost County Retirement an estimated \$23,635. If the supplemental bridge benefit were chosen, deputies would be eligible until 62 years of age with mandatory retirement age of 60 years. Discussion continued. Commissioner McAlpin made the motion to table the resolution until the FWM Committee approves the final budget and with a second by Commissioner Stewart the

motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Stewart suggested removing Resolution #2008-47 from the June County Commission agenda and suggested other committees hear the resolution.

**Circuit Court Budget 08-09 FY**

Circuit Court Clerk Pam Belew presented costs to line item 53100.168 for temporary personnel in the amount of \$7,000. Commissioner Stewart made the motion to approve and with a second by Commissioner McAlpin the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner McAlpin made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Wright the meeting adjourned at 4:37 p.m.
