

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE WEAKLEY COUNTY JAIL A WORKHOUSE

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 41-1202 provides that any county may through action of its quarterly court declare its jail to be a workhouse if such jail be suitable for that purpose, and,

WHEREAS, The Weakley County Quarterly Court is of the opinion that the Weakley County Jail is suitable to be designated a workhouse, and,

WHEREAS, The Weakley County Quarterly Court desires to have the present Weakley County Jail declared a workhouse and operated under the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 41, Chapter 12.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court that:

SECTION 1, The Weakley County Jail is declared to be a workhouse and is subject to the applicable provisions of Title 41, Chapter 12, of the Tennessee Code Annotated.

This resolution shall take effect on July 1, 1975 and as otherwise provided by law the general welfare of the County of Weakley requiring it.
