

A Resolution to Amend the 1976-77 General Fund Appropriation Budget (Ambulance Service)

WHEREAS, Weakley County now has a contract with Pre-Med Ambulance Service, Inc. for emergency medical service for the residents of Weakley County with Weakley County supplementing the contractor \$61,000.00 per fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, the contract allows the contractor the right to discontinue service to the county by giving the county a 120-day notice of his intentions; and,

WHEREAS, Pre-Med Ambulance Service, Inc. exercised the right to discontinue emergency medical service for Weakley County by Officially notifying the county by letter, dated Nov. 18, 1976, and stating the basis for their action was that the county supplement was not sufficient for the service to continue on a profitable basis and further stating that the service was suffering a monthly loss of approximately \$1,700.00. In the notice to discontinue emergency medical service on March 18, 1977 to the county, Pre-Med Ambulance Service, Inc. requested \$1,000.00 additional supplement for the period January through June 1977 to continue under the present contract; and,

WHEREAS, Weakley County has received Antirecession funds from the federal government as authorized by the public works employment act of 1976 (PL94-364) in the amount of \$14,180.00, Federal guidelines covering these funds provides that they may be used to continue present services and maintain present employment levels. These funds must be appropriated within 6 months from date of receipt (November 23, 1976).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Weakley County Quarterly Court that Weakley County continue the present contract with Pre-Med Ambulance Service, Inc. by increasing the supplement and authorizing the expenditure of Federal Antirecession funds as follows:

Motion made by Esq. R. A. Bell that the foregoing and hereto attached resolution be approved, motion seconded by Esq. R. H. Pearson. Upon question called for roll call vote AYE 1 NAY 17 ABSENT 3 : Resolution No. 1977-7 Failed:

Esq. James Porter moves that the Ambulance Committee be given the authority to negotiate for emergency Medical service for Weakley County for the remainder of this year beginning no later than the 19 day of March 1977. Esq. John Harris seconded the motion. Esq. James H. Westbrook, Jr. amended the motion that we shall not exceed the supplement of 61,000.00 dollars based on the unequal monthly installments, Esq. Denton Bell seconded the amended motion. Upon being put to a voice vote motion as amended carried.

Esq. James H. Westbrook, Jr. moved that this motion be amended for the Ambulance Committee to negotiate for a new contract but not change the contract, Esq. Johnny Sharp seconded the motion. Upon being put to a voice vote amendment carried.

Back on motion to give the Ambulance Committee authority to negotiate the remainder of the fiscal year until March 19, 1977, as amended. Question called for on motion: Roll call vote AYE 17 NAY 1 ABSENT 3 : Motion Approved.

RESOLUTION # 1977-7:

A Resolution to Appropriate Federal Antirecession Funds Received Under Title II of the Public Works Employment Act of 1976.

WHEREAS, Weakley County has received Antirecession Fiscal Assistance in the amount of 14,180.00 under Title II of the Public Works Employment Act. of 1976, and

WHEREAS, Federal Guidelines in connection with this fiscal assistance require the local government to expend or appropriate these funds within 6 months from date of receipt; and,

WHEREAS, Weakley County received its first payment on November 23, 1976.
