A Resolution to Amend the 1977-78 Weakley County Highway Department Budget.

WHEREAS, When the 1977-78 Highway Department Budget was adopted, revenue from the State of Tennessee was included and the expenditure authorized to repair Old Highway 22 from Dresden to McKenzie; and

WHEREAS, This expenditure was paid by the State of Tennessee, therefore it was not received by the Weakley County Highway Department.
