RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE  
TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, having committed itself to the improvement of the community which it represents, has determined that rural fire protection is a most pressing need of the community; and

WHEREAS, having determined proper eligibility by CDBG Program guidelines, said governing body wishes to make application for \$300,000.00 in grant funds to implement the afore-mentioned improvements and will commit \$37,100.00 local funds as the remaining share of the total project cost of \$337,100.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Weakley County, meeting in regular session on this the 16th day of September, 1996, that the Weakley County Executive is authorized to sign an application for CDBG funds, to commit general funds (derived from Volunteer Dept. contributions) to the proposed project, and to sign any and all necessary assurances, agreements or contracts required for recipients of CDBG funds.
