

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-25
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE
WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE HIGHWAY FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1998

WHEREAS, certain events have occurred requiring adjustments in the 1997-98 Highway Fund Budget, Fund # 131 and,

WHEREAS, a need has occurred requiring an excessive amount of bridge weight limit signs and posts for the purpose of state compliance on county bridges and,

WHEREAS, the legal services line is in need of more funds to pay the county attorney for the remainder of the fiscal year and,

WHEREAS, a high pressure washer is needed for replacement in the shop due to the excessive cost of repair to the old one and lack of pressure we were in need of for certain asphalt jobs

WHEREAS, these funds are not available elsewhere in the same block of line items,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 17TH day of November, 1997 in Dresden, Tennessee that:





EXPLANATION OF BUDGET TRANSFERS

62000-443 ROAD SIGNS 2000
68000-727 SURPLUS EQUIPMENT (2000)

This transfer is needed because of the excessive amount of weight limit signs needed to bring us back into compliance. D.O.T. is inspecting Weakley County Bridges now.

61000-331 LEGAL SERVICES 2000
39000 FUND BALANCE (2000)

This transfer is needed because of the cost of our county attorney fees being much larger than we expected.

68000-714 HIGHWAY EQUIPMENT 4700
63100-418 EQUIPMENT PARTS (4700)

This transfer is requested because of the need of replacement of the high pressure washer in the shop area. The cost to repair the old one would not be feasible since it would be beneficial in the future to purchase this one with more power that we need for the certain types of jobs.
