

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-79

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LEASE PURCHASE FOR THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUND

WHEREAS, the Weakley County General Purpose School Fund has need of a lease purchase of one Special Education School Bus for the transportation of special education students, and

WHEREAS, the T.C.A. 7-51-904 requires the governing body of the County to approve such lease agreements; and

WHEREAS, the make of the bus is a 1998 Blue Bird, Mini Bird Mounted on a GMC Chassis, VIN # 1GBKP32Y6W330534, Body # M086259, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Weakley County General Purpose Schools to fund this purchase through the Federal Projects Fund of Individuals with Disability Education Act (IDEA), and

WHEREAS, the agreement is entered into 3 payments totaling \$40,643.00 at annual rate of 10%.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 18th day of May, 1998 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County Board of County Commissioners agrees, pursuant to T.C.A. 7-51-904, to the Weakley County General Purpose School Fund entering into a lease purchase agreement for the lease purchase of one Special Education Bus as aforementioned.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the, Board of County Commissioners.
