

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-20
(Amends Resolution 1997-36)

TOBACCO FREE POLICY FOR ALL WEAKLEY COUNTY BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee has the authority to set certain rules of conduct for all county buildings; and

WHEREAS, The Weakley County Personnel Committee met on November 3, 1999 and unanimously voted to recommend to the Weakley County Commission that the use of tobacco in any form inside any county building, owned and operated by Weakley County, be PROHIBITED;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that certain rules of conduct be established in order to protect the appearance, prolong the useful life, reduce the maintenance requirements, and protect the health and welfare of those persons exercising use of said buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Surgeon General of these United States has stated the inhalation of tobacco smoke can be harmful to the physical body.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session, on the 8th day of November, 1999 in Dresden, Tennessee that the use of tobacco in any form inside any county building, owned and operated by Weakley County, be and hereby is **PROHIBITED** effective December 1, 1999.

SECTION 1. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in Conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.


