RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS  
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2001.

WHEREAS, Weakley County has entered into a contract with Griffin Industries, Inc. for the service of dead stock animal removal; and

WHEREAS, Griffin Industries, Inc. will provide this service within forty-eight hours (48) from notification unless unusual circumstances prevent the removal within that time period, the service will be provided five days a week excluding holidays and Griffin Industries will provide service on Saturdays if deads are heavy, but this is only when Griffin Industries, Inc. deems necessary; and

WHEREAS, Griffin Industries, Inc. has implemented an increase in the Dead Stock Animal Removal Service Contract fee effective August 1, 2000 and this contract period will continue for one full year; and

WHEREAS, the 2000-2001 budget appropriates \$7,923 for the Dead Stock Animal Removal Service Contract, the contract increase of \$1,225 is not appropriated in the 2000-2001 FY budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 18<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

CONTRACT PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF DEAD ANIMALS

This agreement is made and entered into by and between GRIFFIN INDUSTRIES, INC., hereafter referred to as GRIFFIN, and WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE.

Subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the parties contract and agree as follows:

1. GRIFFIN, in consideration of \$ 831.60 per month or \$ 9,147.60 per year will remove dead livestock and provide for the disposal of same in WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE.
2. This contract shall commence upon the first day of August and will continue for one year.
3. GRIFFIN INDUSTRIES will provide this service five days a week excluding holidays. GRIFFIN will run Saturday if deads are heavy, but this is only when GRIFFIN deems necessary.
4. The service to be provided by GRIFFIN includes the removal of all farm animals weighing over 100 pounds, except those which have deteriorated to the extent that they cannot be loaded, and except for those that because of the ingestion or assimilation of a non-removable toxin, are not suitable for introduction into the food chain. GRIFFIN INDUSTRIES WILL NOT REMOVE SHEEP OR GOATS.
5. GRIFFIN will move said animals within 48 hours from notification unless unusual circumstances prevent same within that time period.
6. The dead animals to be removed must be situated within 50 feet of a gravel or blacktop road and must be situated where the same may be picked up without interference of fences, buildings or the like. Animals must be ready for removal when GRIFFIN INDUSTRIES arrives.
7. If an autopsy has been performed upon the dead animal, the animal must be closed before picking it up.
8. If live animals are located within the same area wherein the dead animal is located, then assistance must be provided by the owner to ensure that the live animals do not leave the enclosure.
9. GRIFFIN INDUSTRIES will put down animals only if the owner is present.
