**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2001.**

WHEREAS, Weakley County has reserved funds to be specifically used for maintaining the Law Library; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the General Session Judge to maintain the Law Library; and

WHEREAS, the General Session Judge requests to purchase a laptop computer for use in the Law Library and in the courtroom; and

WHEREAS, quotes have been solicited and the cost to purchase the laptop computer will be \$2,250.




