

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-39

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2001.**

WHEREAS, the county buildings budget has experienced increased electrical cost for the 2000-2001 FY; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$15,000 is necessary to complete the remaining fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County is liable for unemployment compensation to prior Weakley County employees that file for unemployment compensation; and

WHEREAS, \$10,000 was budgeted for the 00-01 FY, however, to date \$9,804 has been expensed; and

WHEREAS, the unemployment compensation line must be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 26th day of March 2001 in Dresden, Tennessee that:


SECTION 1. The Weakley County, General Fund is hereby amended as follows:




