

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-42

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN, GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2001.

Whereas the State Division of Property Assessments has informed me that work on the 2002 Reappraisal will begin April 1, 2001, and

Whereas the Reappraisal Plan approved by this commission provides for the county to supply clerical personnel for the reappraisal program and,

Whereas, the current Reappraisal Budget does not include a line item for temporary personnel and,

Whereas, funding for said line could be transferred from existing line #399-Contracted Services, and

NOW, THEREFORE, COMES David Tuck, Assessor, respectfully requesting the establishment of a line #168 (Temporary Personnel) in the amount of \$3000-said amount to be funded by a \$3000 transfer from Line #399 (Contracted Services).
