

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-49

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2001.

WHEREAS, Weakley County appropriated funds for the Christmasville Volunteer Fire Department which is located in District 3; and

WHEREAS, the Christmasville Volunteer Fire Department is no longer in existence and \$750.00 was returned to Weakley County at the close of the fire department; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of District 3 have formed the Pillowville Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of District 3 request that the \$750.00 returned by the Christmasville Volunteer Fire Department be made available to the Pillowville Volunteer Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 21st day of May 2001 in Dresden, Tennessee that \$750.00 be appropriated for the Pillowville Volunteer Fire Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
