**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A COUNTY BRIDGE
TO BE NAMED FOR ROAD BOARD MEMBER**

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Board of Highway Commissioners have unanimously agreed To request the naming of a bridge on Old Salem Rd. near Martin to be named **Eddie Fuqua Bridge**.

WHEREAS, Eddie Fuqua served on the Road Board for a period of twenty years and served in World War II in all five major battles.

WHEREAS, Eddie Fuqua was deceased in May 2002 and the Road Board feels that he is due This recognition of having a bridge named in memory of him on the road near His home.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Weakley County Board of Commissioners assembled in regular session on this the 24th day of June, 2002 does hereby approve the naming of a bridge on Old Salem Rd. to be named **Eddie Fuqua Bridge**.
