RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE ADOPTION OF DRESDEN'S URBAN GROWTH  
BOUNDARY AS ITS PLANNING REGION

WHEREAS, the Dresden Municipal Planning Commission has adopted a resolution requesting the Local Government Planning Advisory Committee, pursuant to Section 12-3-102, Tennessee Code, to create a Town of Dresden Planning Region comprising the area delineated on the attached map and consents to the Local Government Planning Advisory Committee designation that the Dresden Municipal Planning Commission serve as the Dresden Regional Planning Commission for the entire region; and

WHEREAS, planning and control of development beyond the corporate limits is of vital interest to the Town of Dresden.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Commission that this body endorses the request of the Dresden Municipal Planning Commission to the Local Government Planning Advisory Committee that a Dresden Planning Region, as shown on the attached map entitled Dresden Planning Region, be created and that the Dresden Municipal Planning Commission be designated the Dresden Regional Planning Commission for the entire region.
