

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-36

**2004-2005 FY TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR THE WEAKLEY COUNTY
GENERAL FUND, WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY FUND,
WEAKLEY COUNTY DEBT SERVICE FUND, WEAKLEY COUNTY
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FUND, AND SOLID WASTE FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2004.**

WHEREAS, due to the State of Tennessee, Department of Education, and other state departments not providing current financial budget information to Weakley County in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, county revenue from the state budget is vital to preparing the Weakley County Revenue and Expenditure Budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 28th day of June 2004 in Dresden, Tennessee that the adopted Weakley County 2003-2004 General Fund, Highway Fund, Debt Service Fund, Department of Education, and Solid Waste Fund budgets be adopted as the 2004-2005 FY Tentative Budget; and

SECTION 1. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no more than 1/12th of any item be expended per calendar month by each Department without the approval of the Weakley County Board of Commissioners Finance, Ways, and Means Committee until the final 2004-2005 FY Budget is adopted.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.




