

**RESOLUTION NO. 2005-07  
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR  
THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE HIGHWAY FUND  
LITTER AND TRASH COLLECTION  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2005**

**WHEREAS,** less revenue than anticipated will be received from the Tennessee Dept. of Transportation For the Litter and Trash Collection Grant and,

**WHEREAS,** this budget amendment is to realign the revenue received from Tennessee Dept. of Transportation Litter Grant Division which is \$11,441 less than anticipated and,

**WHEREAS,** the amount originally set up in the 2004-05 budget needs to be decreased by \$11,441 which will be a total of \$39,752 to be received as revenue and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2004 in Dresden, Tennessee that this resolution is hereby approved to decrease revenue for the Litter and Trash Grant.






