**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, TO AMEND WEAKLEY COUNTY'S  
DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY:**

**WHEREAS**, the Weakley County Commission passed Resolution 2004-44 adopting the Weakley County Drug-Free Workplace and Substance Abuse Policy in June 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, an amendment is needed in the Alcohol Testing Methodology section on page 14 of the Weakley County Drug-Free Workplace and Substance Abuse Policy; and

**WHEREAS**, the words "the drawing of blood by trained medical personnel" should be deleted and the words "certified breathalyzer machine which measures the breath alcohol content" should be substituted.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 21st day of November 2005 in Dresden, Tennessee that the Drug-Free Workplace Substance Abuse Policy for Weakley County, Tennessee Government be amended as attached.






