

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-03  
RESOLUTION TO URGE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
TO EXTEND THE ONE-HALF CENT SALES TAX

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Legislative Body recognizes the importance of education for our Community; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Weakley County Legislative Body are fully aware of the rewards a community can receive from a quality educational system as well as the detrimental effects on a community when such a system is unavailable; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Legislative Body also recognizes that the tax structure of Tennessee may need reform, but the immediate problem of adequate funding for education must be addressed; and


WHEREAS, an estimated \$1.6 million was received by Weakley County for education from the one-half cent sales tax and such revenues are crucial to adequate funding for the Weakley County school system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on this the 19th day of January, 1993, in Dresden, Tennessee, that:

SECTION 1. The Tennessee General Assembly is strongly urged to extend the one-half cent sales tax to be used for the basic education program in Tennessee.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it. The county clerk of Weakley County is requested to immediately transmit a copy of this resolution to the members of the Tennessee General Assembly representing Weakley County.


